The Festival will include entertainment; carnival rides and games; food, Bingo, and a book sale; the announcement of the Outstanding Citizen; art, photo and talent shows; a community information day; a craft fair; a parade, and much more. This year, the Festival runs from Friday, September 1st through Monday, September 4th (Labor Day).

The Greenbelt Labor Day Festival is an ALL volunteer organization. The Festival is staffed, organized, and conducted by volunteers, and it's one of the largest all-volunteer festivals in the state of Maryland.
